XRF instruments are used to detect levels of lead in any paint sample instantaneously. The incorporation of these instruments allows us to assist our clients with the fastest turnaround times in Northern California. As a result, this allows you to clear abatement/mitigation areas faster, help meet insurance company demands for restoration response times, and overall help projects where speed is of the utmost importance.

A Mycometer is a device used for measuring airborne fungal spores, also known as fungal spores. It is often used in the indoor air quality industry to determine the presence and levels of mold and other fungi in buildings, homes and other environments. The device utilizes a laser-based technology to count and quantify fungal spores in air samples, providing fast and accurate results for fungal contamination assessments.

CAL-OSHA ASBESTOS TESTING REQUIREMENTS

The California Division of Occupational Safety and Health (Cal/OSHA) has issued a letter to employers regarding the requirement to obtain samples for asbestos in all structures, **regardless of the age of the building.** The letter emphasizes the importance of identifying the presence of asbestos in order to protect employees from exposure to this hazardous substance.

Cal/OSHA requires employers to obtain samples for asbestos from all structures prior to renovation or demolition work. This includes both commercial and residential buildings, regardless of the age of the structure. The samples must be taken by a qualified asbestos inspector and sent to a laboratory for analysis.

The letter from Cal/OSHA serves as a reminder to employers of their obligation to protect workers from exposure to asbestos. Failure to comply with these requirements can result in fines and legal action.



By taking the necessary precautions, employers can ensure the health and safety of their employees, as well as protect themselves from legal liability.
